


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




High lift lever

Allows you to remove crumpets, muffins and small pieces of toast safely without burning your fingers.

Electronic browning control

variable toast settings from I-6 with additional frozen setting; allows you to toast your bread to the desired colour, consistently.

Removable crumb tray

Push to release the large crumb tray from underneath your toaster for easy cleaning.

Extra wide & deep bread slots

Enables you to toast a large variety of breads - regardless of thickness

Self centering bread slots

Whether you are toasting thick or thin bread, your bread will always be held in the centre of the slot to ensure even toasting.

Crumpet Setting

This cooks crumpets to perfection. Specifically designed crumpet feature emits extra heat from the centre element, to cook the top of your crumpet perfectly, without burning the bottom.

Cancel button

Immediately interrupts any toasting cycle and pops the toast up.























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
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Crumpet Setting

BEFORE FIRST USE

Remove any promotional material attached to your toaster.

OPERATION OF YOUR TOASTER

- · Insert the plug into a suitable mains supply.
- · Position the bread in the bread slot.
- Select the desired colour setting on the electronic browning control. When using the toaster for the first time we suggest that you set the variable browning control to 3.
- · Push the toasting lever down to commence the toasting cycle.
- When the desired colour setting is achieved, the toaster will automatically turn off and slide the toast up. If you need to remove the toast before the cycle is complete, press the Cancel button. The Cancel button will immediately interrupt the toasting cycle and slide the toast up.
- · To remove small pieces of bread such as bagels, crumpets or muffins use the High lift lever to lift the toast above the starting position. This will prevent burning your fingers as you remove the toast.

NOTE: Do not toast stale bread, rice crackers or similar on a high setting as they may catch fire.

TOASTING FROZEN BREAD

Place the bread into the bread slots and select the frozen setting on the electronic variable browning control dial.

Lower the bread into the toaster by pressing down the lever on the front of the toaster.

NOTE: The toasting cycle can be stopped at any time by pressing the cancel button.


2-SLICE OPERATION (TT33 ONLY)


To toast two slices of bread:

- · Insert the bread in the left or right-hand pair of slots.
- · Use the browning control and carriage control lever associated with that pair of slots.

TOASTING CRUMPETS

1. Position the crumpets facing inwards, as shown





- 3. Push the toasting lever down to commence the cycle.
- 4. Then press the crumpet button.
- 5. To remove your crumpet use the high lift lever to lift the crumpet above the starting position. This will prevent burning your finger as you remove the crumpet.
























CARE AND CLEANING

Always turn the power OFF and remove the plug from TO CLEAN THE TOASTER INTERIOR the power outlet after use and before cleaning your toaster.

TO CLEAN THE EXTERIOR.

Wipe exterior with a slightly dampened cloth and polish with a soft dry cloth.

NOTE: DO NOT USE METAL SCOURERS OR ABRASIVES AS THIS MAY SCRATCH THE EXTERIOR SURFACE.

Clean inside the toaster regularly. To do this, unplug the appliance, turn it upside down over the sink and gently shake all the crumbs out.






To remove the crumbs, simply push and slide out the tray, empty and place it back in the toaster.

CAUTION: NEVER IMMERSE THE MAIN UNIT, CORD SET OR PLUG IN WATER OR ALLOW MOISTURE TO COME IN CONTACT WITH THESE PARTS.

We at Breville are very safety conscious. We design and manufacture consumer products with the safety of you, our valued customer foremost in mind. In addition we ask that you exercise a degree of care when using any electrical appliance and adhere to the following precautions:

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS FOR YOUR CAFE SERIES TOASTER

This appliance has been designed specifically for the purpose of toasting breads, bagels and crumpets only.

- · Always use the appliance on a dry, level surface.
- · Never immerse the main unit, cord set or plug in water, or allow moisture to come in contact with
- · Keep clear of walls, curtains and other heat or steam sensitive materials. Minimum 200mm distance.
- · The appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- · Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, touch hot surfaces or become knotted.
- · Do not place on or near a hot gas burner, electric element, or in a heated oven.

- This appliance is intended for household use only. Do not use this appliance for other than it's intended
- · Do not use outdoors.
- Do not operate the toaster on an inclined surface.
- · Do not move the toaster while it is switched on.
- Always turn the power off at the power outlet and then remove the plug from the power outlet before attempting to move the appliance, when the appliance is not in use and before cleaning or storing.
- Regularly inspect thie power cord, plug and actual appliance for any damage. If found damaged in any way, immediately cease use of the appliance and return unit to the Breville Customer Service Department for examination, replacement or repair.



























Please read these instructions before operating this appliance and retain for future use.

ALWAYS

- ✓ **Always** ensure hands are dry before handling the plug or switching on the toaster.
- ✓ **Always** use the toaster on a secure, dry, level surface.
- ✓ **Always** allow adequate air space above and on all sides for air circulation. Do not allow the appliance to touch curtains, wallcoverings, clothing, dishtowels or other flammable materials during use. Do not use under cupboards or curtains.
- ✓ Caution is required on surfaces where heat may cause a problem an insulated heat pad is recommended.
- ✓ **Always** use the toaster with the crumb tray in place.
- ✓ Always regularly clean the crumb tray. Do not allow crumbs to build up.
- ✓ **Always** unplug from the socket when not in use and before cleaning.
- ✓ Always allow the toaster to cool before cleaning and storing.
- ✓ **Always** carry out regular checks of the supply cord to ensure no damage is evident. Should there be any signs that the cord is damaged in the slightest degree, the entire appliance should be returned to the Customer Service Department.
- ✓ **Always** return the toaster after a malfunction, or if it has been damaged in any manner to the Customer Service Department for examination, repair or adjustment as special purpose tools are required.

CAUTION:THIS APPLIANCE GENERATES HEAT DURING USE. PROPER PRECAUTIONS MUST BE TAKEN TO PREVENT THE RISK OF BURNS, SCALDS, FIRES OR OTHER DAMAGE TO PERSONS OR PROPERTY CAUSED BY TOUCHING THE EXTERIOR WHILST IN **USE OR DURING COOLING.**

- X Never touch hot surfaces.
- X Never use this appliance outdoors.
- X Never use this appliance for other thanit's intended use. This appliance is for household use only.
- X Never allow children to use this appliance. Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is near children.
- X Never leave the appliance unattended when in use as the bread may burn.
- X Never let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, touch hot surfaces or become knotted.
- X Never place this appliance on or near a hot gas or electric burner or where it could touch a heated oven or microwave oven.
- X Never use this appliance with any foodstuff containing sugar or products containing jam or preserves.
- X Never immerse any part of the toaster, or cordset and plug in water or any other liquid to protect against electrical hazards.
- X Never use harsh, abrasive or caustic cleaners to clean this appliance.
- X Never operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug, after an appliance malfunction or if it has been damaged in any manner.

WARNING:NEVER ATTEMPT TO EXTRACT JAMMED TOAST, MUFFINS, BAGELS OR ANY OTHER ITEM WITH A KNIFE OR ANY OTHER OBJECT. AS CONTACT WITH LIVE ELEMENTS COULD RESULT IN AN **ELECTRIC SHOCK. ALLOW THE APPLIANCE TO** COOL. UNPLUG AND CAREFULLY REMOVE THE BREAD.



























CONNECTION TO THE MAINS SUPPLY

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed.

WARNING:THIS APPLIANCE MUST BE EARTHED.


If this appliance is fitted with a rewirable BS1363, 13 amp plug, the fuse should be rated at 13 amps and be ASTA approved to BS1362. However if the plug is unsuitable, it should be dismantled and removed from the supply cord and an appropriate plug fitted.

If this appliance is fitted with a moulded BS1363 13 amp plug, the fuse should be rated at 13 amps and be ASTA approved to BS1362. If the fuse in a non-rewirable plug needs to be changed, the fuse cover must be refitted. The appliance must not be used without the fuse cover fitted.

In the event of the plug being unsuitable, it should be changed and an appropriate plug fitted. If you remove the plug it must not be connected to a 13 amp socket and the plug must be disposed of immediately.

As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:

NOTE: The wires of the mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code: **GREEN & YELLOW = EARTH BLUE = NEUTRAL BROWN = LIVE**



- The wire which is coloured **GREEN & YELLOW** must be connected to the terminal in your plug which is marked with an E or by the EARTH SYMBOL or coloured GREEN or GREEN & YELLOW.
- The wire coloured **BLUE** is the **NEUTRAL** and must be connected to the terminal in your plug which is marked N or coloured BLACK.
- The wire coloured **BROWN** is the **LIVE** and must be connected to the terminal in your plug which is marked L or coloured RED.
- If any other plug is used, a 13 amp fuse must be fitted either in the plug or adaptor or at the distributor board.

























AFTERSALES SERVICE

These appliances are built to the very highest of standards. There are no user serviceable parts. Follow these steps if the unit fails to operate:

- I. Check instructions have been followed correctly.
- 2. Check fuse has not blown.
- 3. Check mains supply is functional.

If the appliance will still not operate return the appliance to the place it was purchased for a replacement.

To return the appliance to the Customer Service Department, follow the steps below:

- I. Pack it carefully, preferably in the original carton. Ensure the unit is clean.
- 2. Enclose your name and address and quote Model TT30/TT33 in all correspondence.
- 3. Give the reason you are returning it.
- 4. If within the guarantee period, state when and where it was purchased and include proof of purchase (e.g. till receipt).
